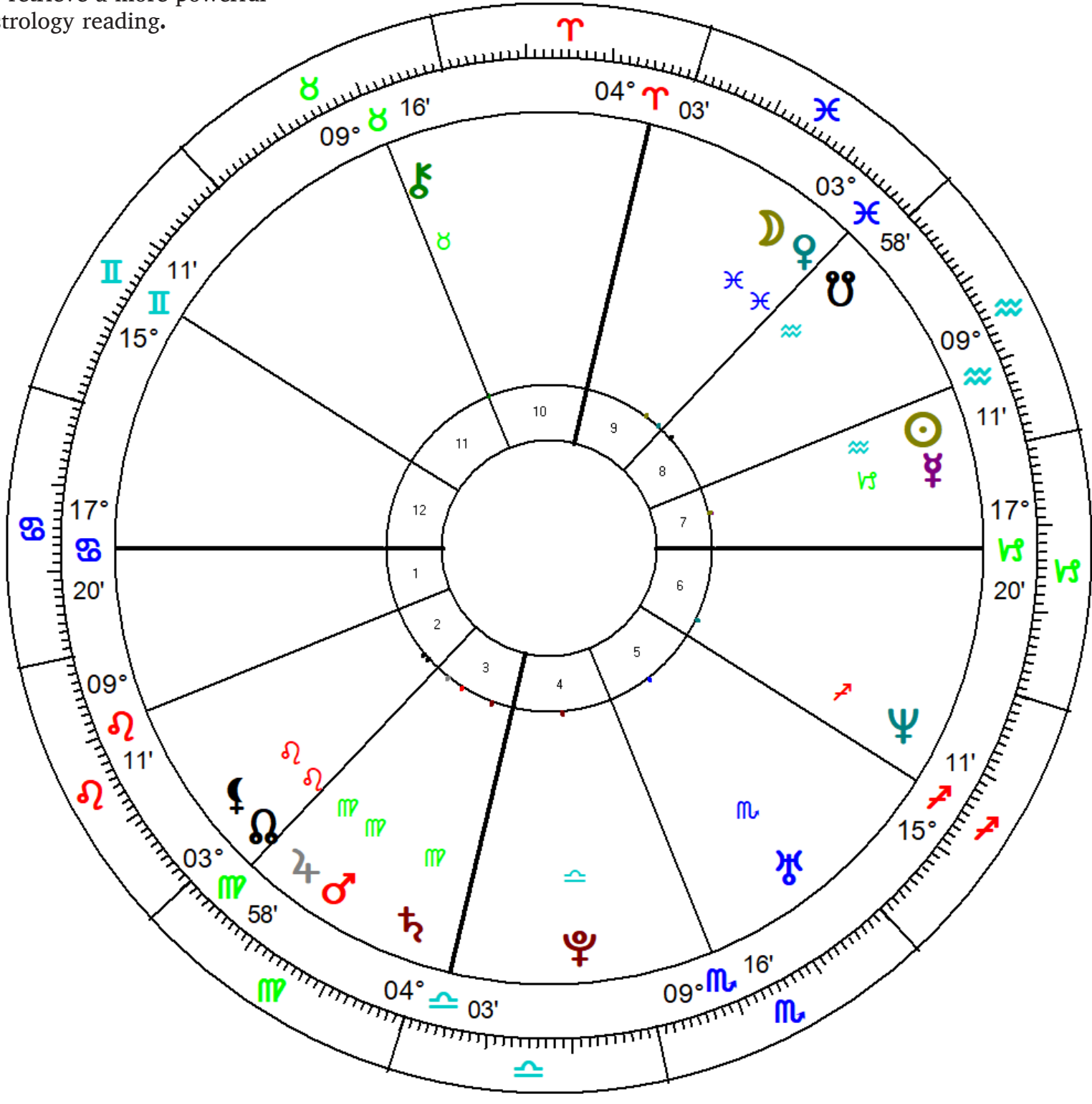
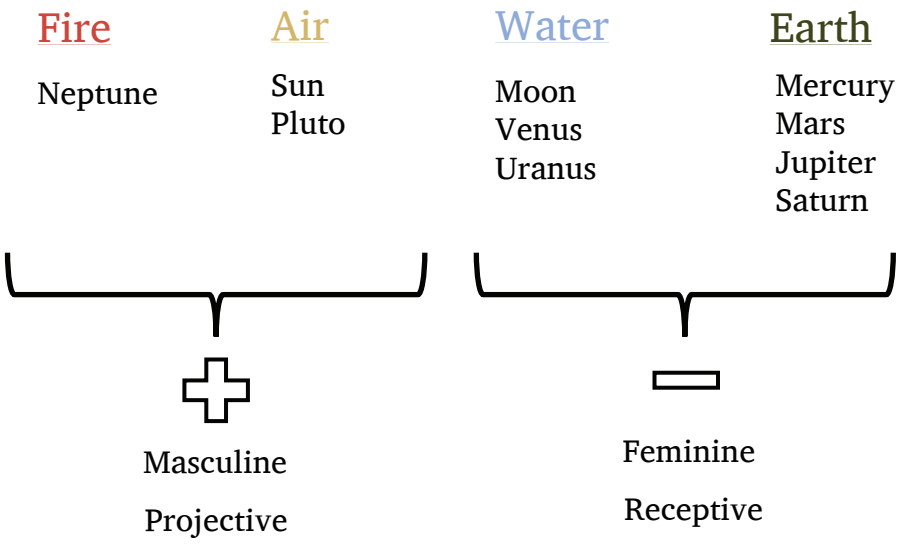

Astrology Patterns with Tarot.

In this lecture, I will use my astrology chart to demonstrate how we can learn the patterns and symbols of astrology which represent the vibration we carry into incarnation and also how Tarot will assist with the necessary symbolism for our subconsciousness to respond more accurately to our life destiny.

This lecture will build upon the previous lecture and I will create fragments of my astrology chart by using the whole life perspective and the quadrant system.

This lecture will not be an typical astrology reading for the purpose is to demonstrate how to use Tarot, Qabalah, and Astrology in order to retrieve a more powerful astrology reading.



2: Quadrant System: 'Needs'

The Astrology quadrant system provides more details of previous incarnations, of what we 'need' to do, what we don't 'need' to do, what we 'intend' to do, and what we don't 'intend' to do.

We can discover patterns that reveal to us our pre-birth 'needs' and 'intentions' on what we desire to learn, experience, and accomplish within our lifetime.

Let us remember that with our astrology chart, we can view:
the House size represents our past,
the Zodiac sign represents our present,
and the Planets will represent our future.

The difference between 'needs' and 'intent' can be discovered from the size of the houses by degrees on our astrology wheel along with the placement of the planets in the house.

A 'need' would be considered a weakness, or a difficulty to develop, and also a focus of work that we should aim to accomplish in this lifetime.

For example, my 1st and 7th house of 22 degrees are the smallest in my chart, which determines my greatest 'need' in this incarnation.

A house with 30 degrees is perfectly balanced, as seen in my 3rd and 9th house.

My 2nd and 8th house of 25 degrees is also less than 30 degrees, which creates an imbalance for another 'need' to work on within this lifetime.

These four small houses provide the clue that in previous incarnations I struggled with the attributions and qualities that are assigned to those particular houses.

The large fourth, fifth, sixth, tenth, eleventh, and twelfth houses provide the other clue that in previous incarnations, I focused more in those areas of work than my four smaller houses.

The large houses also indicate that my subconsciousness has already experienced and somewhat mastered those areas of life, which means although that type of work would come easier to me in this life, I would be 'missing the mark' of my pre-birth 'needs' to create balance in my current life and accomplish my overall life goal, which is why the symbols of Astrology, Tarot, and Qabalah are so important.

I can tune-in and channel my large houses with symbols that speak to my subconsciousness that will assist me in my mental imagery to create the potentialities for me to clearly see on how to confront my pre-birth 'needs' and 'intentions'.

3: Quadrant System: 'Intentions'

With the 'needs' being a primary focus of work in this lifetime, we also arrange pre-birth 'intentions' which can assist in accomplishing the work we desire to develop that can be useful and advantageous.

Our planets represent 'intentions' and their placement on our astrology chart will determine the imprint upon our signature vibration, which is the clue of how we can diversify our energy toward the work we want to accomplish.

With simple math of the ten planets that are within us that equal 100% of our daily energy, we can create a perspective of how we might delegate our life energy on a daily basis.

We do not include our North Node, South Node, Chiron, or Black Moon, for this calculation.

Within my astrology chart, the 1st quadrant of Personal Development has three planets, the 2nd quadrant of Family Development has three planets, the 3rd quadrant of Social Development has four planets, the 4th quadrant of Career Development has zero planets.

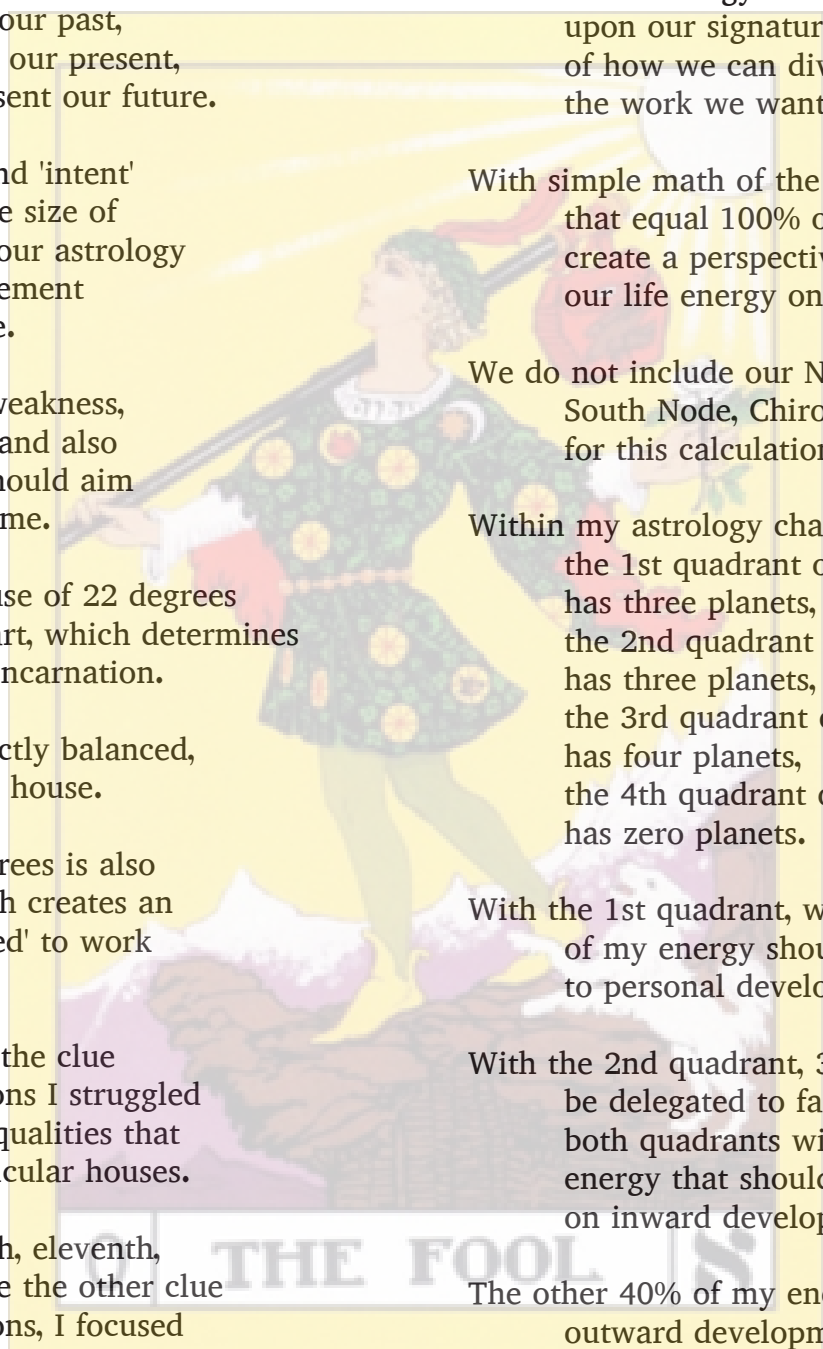
With the 1st quadrant, we can notice that 30% of my energy should be delegated to personal development.

With the 2nd quadrant, 30% of my energy should be delegated to family development which both quadrants will total 60% of my daily energy that should be focused and balanced on inward development.

The other 40% of my energy should focus on my outward development, which the 3rd quadrant has 4 planets to equal a total of 40%.

My 4th quadrant has no planets for 'intentions' toward career development, which means I really should focus on the qualities of the 7th, 8th, and 9th Houses for my outward development in this life.

Now that we have a clear perspective of how 'needs' and 'intentions' are implemented as an overview for the quadrant system, we can separate each quadrant as a fragment to approximate with symbol on how we use our energy for development in this lifetime.



4: 1st Quadrant

We will now discuss each of the four quadrants as an overview to identify the symbols that are in relation to the pre-birth 'needs' and pre-birth 'intent's'.

Afterwards, we will discuss each of the twelve houses within the four quadrants which reveals fragments of work that can be a focal point to meet the pre-birth 'needs' and ultimately attain our flow state for consciousness growth.

Within my astrology chart, I have a small 1st quadrant because the 1st, 2nd, and 3rd houses, when added together are less than 90 degrees.

This means my 1st quadrant of personal development needs more attention in this lifetime than my 2nd quadrant of family development and 4th quadrant of career development which are both greater than 90 degrees.

The concept of small houses that provide the indication of the pre-birth 'needs' can be applied the same to small quadrants.

In review, let us remember that the house sizes represent the past, zodiac signs represent the present, and the planets represent the future.

At this time in this lecture, I will not provide details on the planet placements, but they will be discussed after the four quadrants have been sufficiently examined and explained with Tarot and Zodiac signs.

Each of the four quadrants will have the Foundation layer and the Personality layer.

Within the 1st quadrant, the 1st House is home of Aries and with Tarot, Aries is assigned to Key 4, The Emperor.

The 2nd House is home of Taurus and with Tarot, Taurus is assigned to Key 5, The Hierophant.

The 3rd House is home of Gemini and with Tarot, Gemini is assigned to Key 6, The Lovers.

We can use the attributions and properties of the 1st, 2nd, and 3rd houses as the Foundation layer of what 'needs' to be worked on for personal development.

To build upon the Foundation layer, we can implement the Personality layer of our astrology chart, which will represent the initial position of our atomic structure on our chromosomal strand within our DNA molecules at human birth.

The Personality layer is what changes the characteristics of us as individuals which has to do with the distance between the atoms on our chromosomal strand.

Each quadrant represents a different genetic potential and also represents the possible different phase in our life which these qualities will be more pronounced than other areas or phases in our life.

Each astrological planet represents a genetic potential to accomplish something in a certain area of our lives, which is why the planets represent our 'intent' and also our future.

Our life-line determines where we are within the phases of our life which are represented by the degree within a Zodiac sign.

Our life-line will also phase-in planets that become activated within us to make effort on accomplishing our pre-birth 'intent's'.

The life-line will be discussed in more detail later in this lecture, but for now let us focus on the model used for the quadrant system and know that the 1st and 2nd quadrant is the first half of a human life.

For each quadrant, there is an assigned ruler which can be found on the leading cusp.

My astrology chart has the 1st quadrant ruled by the zodiac sign of Cancer.

This means that I can use the symbols and attributions of Cancer to assist with my pre-birth 'needs' of my 1st quadrant, which are referenced on the Foundation layer.

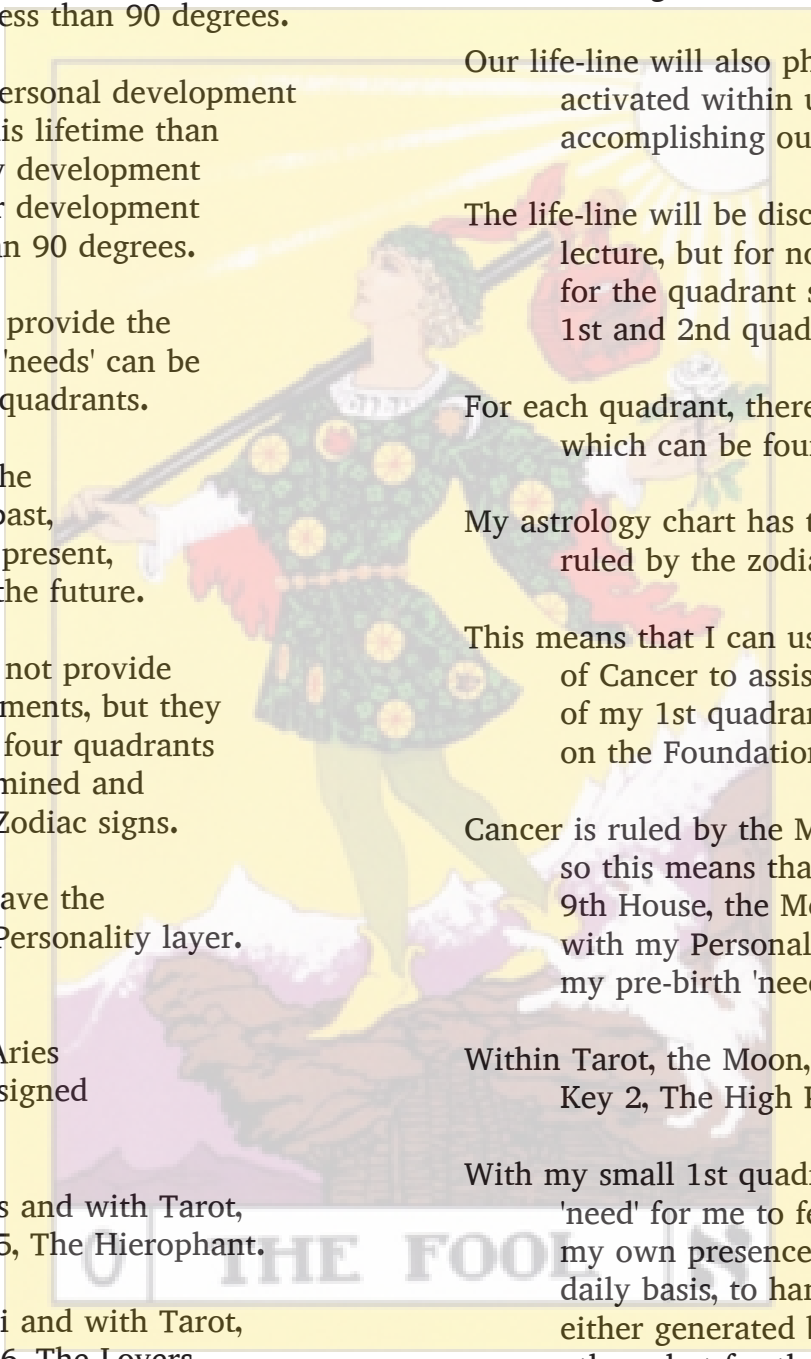
Cancer is ruled by the Moon, which is located in my 9th house, so this means that I can apply the attributions of the 9th House, the Moon, and the Zodiac sign of Pisces with my Personality layer to work on resolving my pre-birth 'needs' of the 1st quadrant.

Within Tarot, the Moon, is assigned to Key 2, The High Priestess.

With my small 1st quadrant, there is a strong 'need' for me to feel on my own, to be within my own presence, to be physically active on a daily basis, to handle heavy emotions that are either generated by myself or received from others, but for those emotions to be addressed carefully and non-personally.

5: 2nd Quadrant

For my 2nd quadrant, the summation of my 4th, 5th, and 6th houses are greater than 90 degrees, which means I did not account for pre-birth 'needs' within family development.



This does not imply that I will not have any activity for developing a family because of the large quadrant size, but it does imply the importance of my 1st and 3rd small quadrants which are personal development and social development.

I should have awareness that the large quadrants will come easier to develop in this life, whereas the small quadrants indicate difficulties for possibly creating the experiences I 'need', but are essential for my consciousness growth.

On the Foundation layer, the 2nd quadrant begins with the 4th House, which is home of Cancer and with Tarot, Cancer is assigned to Key 7, The Chariot.

The 5th house is home of Leo and with Tarot, Leo is assigned to Key 8, Strength.

The 6th house is home of Virgo and with Tarot, Virgo is assigned to Key 9, The Hermit.

We can use the attributions and properties of the 4th, 5th, and 6th houses as the Foundation layer of what would have been 'needed' to be worked for my family development if the quadrant was considered small and less than 90 degrees.

My large 2nd quadrant is implying that my previous incarnations addressed a lot of energy toward consciousness growth within family development and is already within my subconsciousness.

To build upon the Foundation layer, my Personality layer has Libra as the leading cusp for the 2nd quadrant which means the ruler is Venus, and Venus is in the 9th House of Pisces, which is assigned to Key 18, The Moon, and with Venus assigned to Key 3, The Empress.

I can use these symbols and attributions to assist with my family development in this lifetime, but the 4th, 5th, and 6th houses are already well developed which means I can focus, tune-in, and channel my 2nd quadrant for these particular qualities that are already established within my subconsciousness.

The planets imply I have an 'intent', to be more sensitive to the 'needs' of those I love and care about within my family dynamics.

We'll discuss the planets and 2nd quadrant houses in more detail after we finish the overview of the 3rd and 4th quadrant.

6: 3rd Quadrant

For my 3rd quadrant, the summation of my 7th, 8th, and 9th houses are less than 90 degrees, which means I have pre-birth 'needs' within social development.

We can use the attributions and properties of the 7th, 8th, and 9th houses as the Foundation layer of the pre-birth 'needs' that can be worked for my social development in this lifetime.

The small 3rd quadrant is the same size as my 1st quadrant, which implies that I focus more on the development of 2nd quadrant family development and 4th quadrant career development in previous incarnations.

On the Foundation layer, the 3rd quadrant begins with the 7th House, which is home of Libra and with Tarot, Libra is assigned to Key 11, Justice.

The 8th house is home of Scorpio and with Tarot, Scorpio is assigned to Key 13, Death.

The 9th house is home of Sagittarius and with Tarot, Sagittarius is assigned to Key 14, Temperance.

To build upon the Foundation layer, my Personality layer has Capricorn as the leading cusp for the 3rd quadrant which means the ruler is Saturn, and Saturn is in my 3rd House of Virgo, which is assigned to Key 9, The Hermit, and with Saturn assigned to Key 21, The World.

The four planets within my 3rd quadrant send a clear message of strong 'intent' to focus on social development 'needs' in this small quadrant.

We'll discuss the planets and 3rd quadrant houses in more detail after we finish the overview of the 4th quadrant.

7: 4th Quadrant

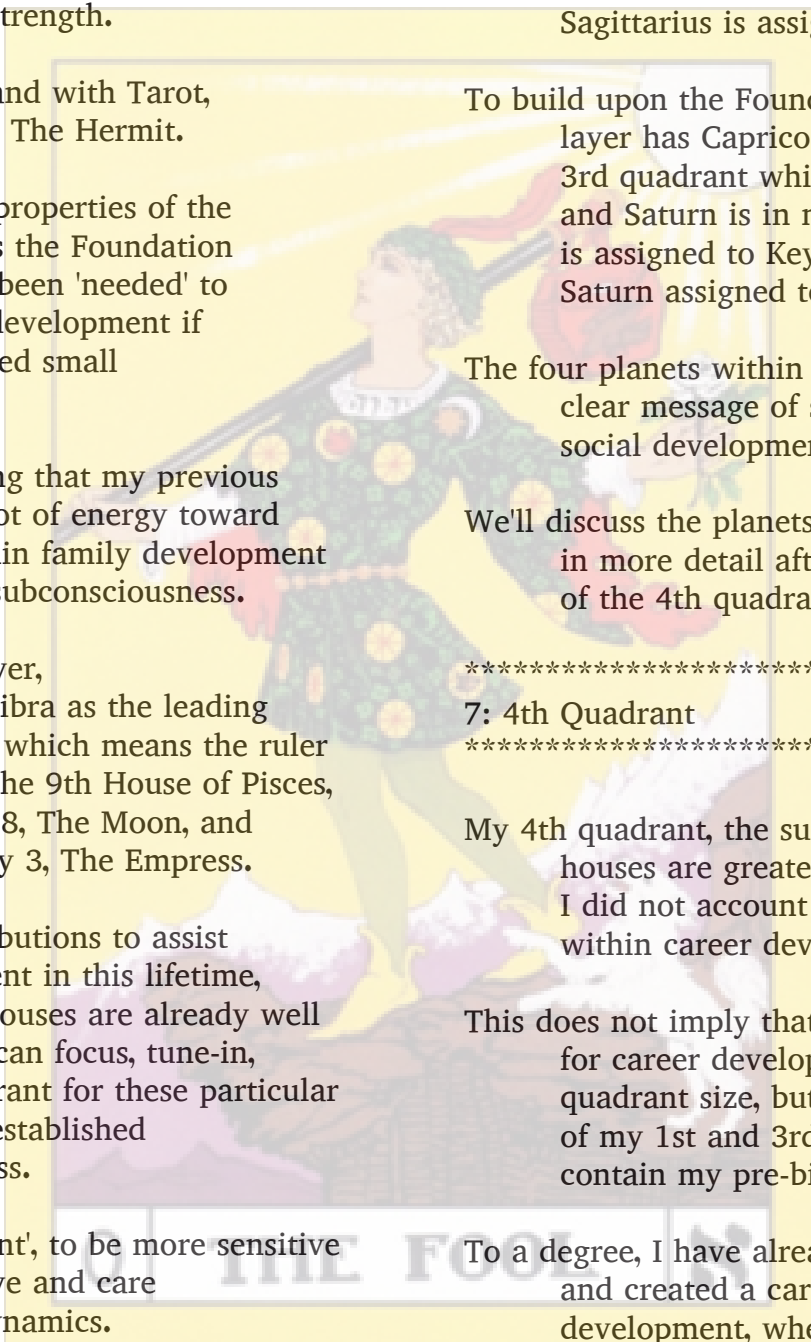
My 4th quadrant, the summation of my 10th, 11th, and 12th houses are greater than 90 degrees, which means I did not account for pre-birth 'needs' within career development.

This does not imply that I will not have any activity for career development because of the large quadrant size, but it does imply the importance of my 1st and 3rd small quadrants which contain my pre-birth 'needs'.

To a degree, I have already tuned-in to my 4th quadrant and created a career early in my life for software development, whereas I have let most of the career diminish from a linear standpoint by choice, but I still have the skillsets and tools from that phase earlier in my life to aid my 1st and 3rd quadrant developments for consciousness growth and to meet my pre-birth 'needs'.

For the Foundation layer, the 4th quadrant begins with 10th House, which is home of Capricorn and with Tarot, Capricorn is assigned to Key 15, The Devil.

The 11th House is home of Aquarius and with Tarot, Aquarius is assigned to Key 17, The Star.



The 12th House is home of Pisces and with Tarot, Pisces is assigned to Key 18, The Moon.

As for my Personality layer that builds onto the Foundation layer, the leading cusp of my 4th quadrant is Aries, which means the ruler of this quadrant is Mars and located in my 3rd House of Virgo, and in Tarot, Virgo is assigned to Key 9, The Hermit, with Mars assigned to Key 16, The Tower.

The 4th quadrant houses are empty with no planets that means I have no pre-birth 'intent' for career development in this lifetime.

This sends a clear message that I should not focus much on these qualities of the 4th quadrant due to previous incarnations where I have already established within my subconsciousness much experiences with extensive career development.

8: Summary

I will conclude this section of the lecture of the astrology quadrant system which includes symbols and patterns that we can use to isolate our pre-birth 'needs' and pre-birth 'intent' from an overview perspective.

We have identified and established the rulers of each quadrant on the Personality layer which will aid our focus on how to penetrate to the Foundation layer and use the symbols, attributions, and qualities in order to create suggestions for our subconsciousness that ultimately will manifest the desired experiences to accomplish our life destiny.

In the next video, we will explore all twelve houses within the four quadrants and continue to use my astrology chart so that I can explain clearly how the symbols and patterns are identified in my life through personal experience.

I will also explain the importance of finding our life-line and knowing our phases of life as we begin from birth and travel through the quadrants in order to build our life to accomplish our ambitions of pre-birth 'needs' and 'intent'.
