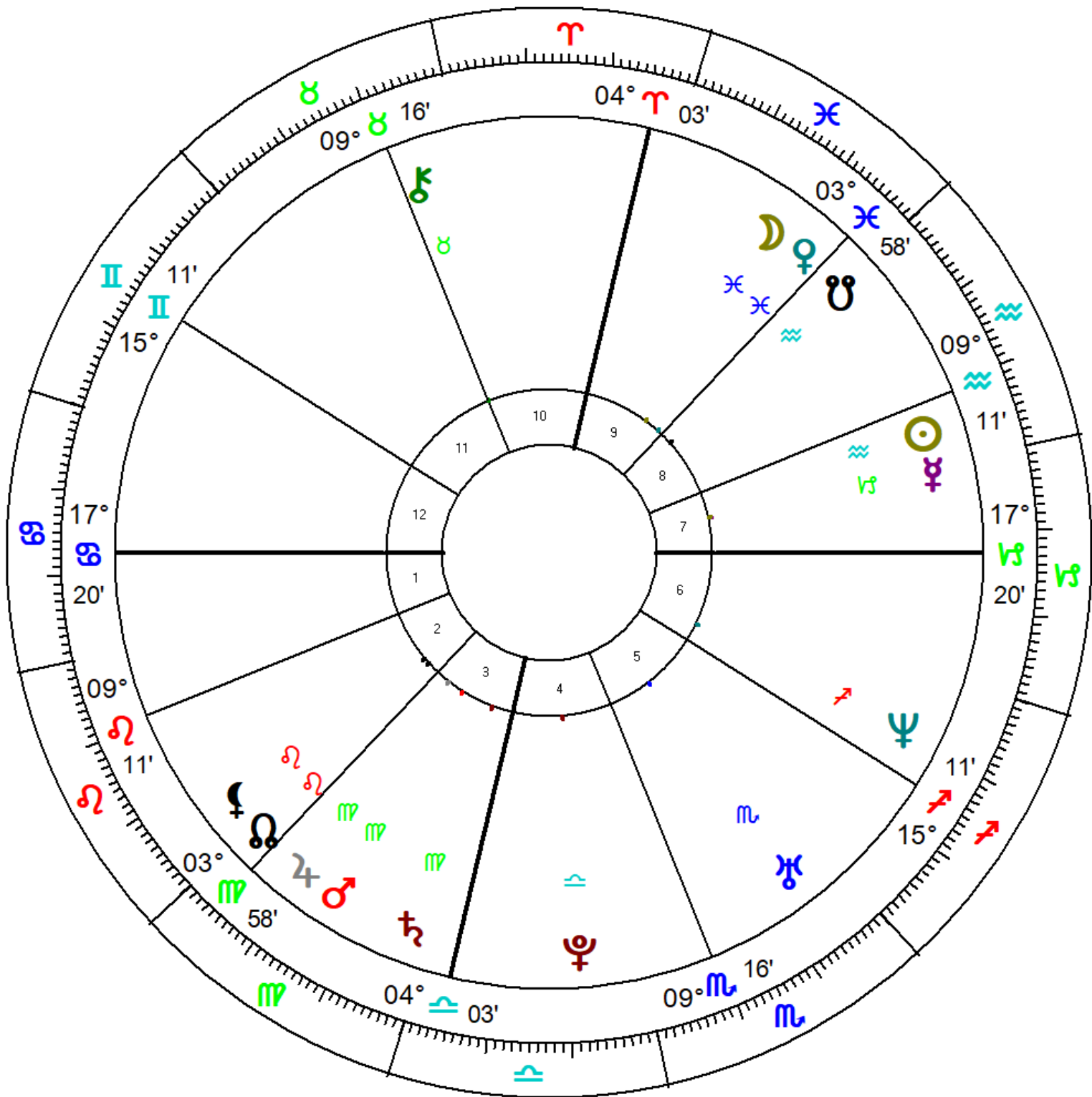
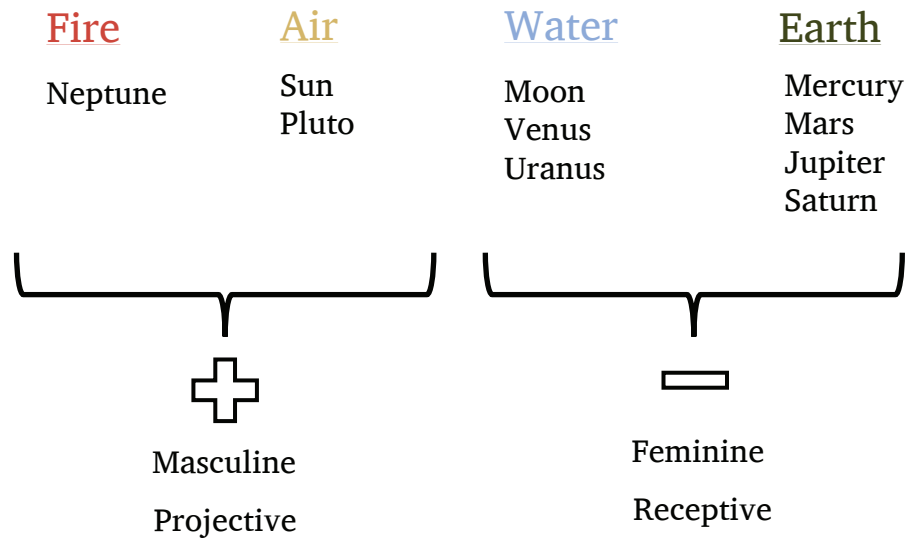
 1: Title

Astrology Patterns with Tarot.

In this lecture, I will continue to use my Astrology chart to demonstrate how we can learn the patterns and symbols of Astrology with Tarot to assist with our subconscious response for a more accurate overview with our life destiny.

In the previous lecture, we focused on the 2nd Quadrant rulers of the Personality layer and the Foundation layer which includes the 4th, 5th, and 6th Houses.

In this lecture, we will move my life-line through the 3rd Quadrant and determine the rulers for the 7th, 8th, and 9th Houses.



2: Quadrant Rulers

We have identified and established the rulers of each quadrant on the Personality layer of my astrology chart.

The 1st Quadrant is ruled by the Zodiac sign Cancer and Key 7, The Chariot, which has the ruling Planet of the Moon.

The 2nd Quadrant is ruled by the Zodiac sign Libra and Key 11, Justice, which has the ruling Planet of Venus.

The 3rd Quadrant is ruled by the Zodiac sign Capricorn and Key 15, The Devil, which has the ruling Planet of Saturn.

The 4th Quadrant is ruled by the Zodiac sign Aries and Key 4, The Emperor, which has the ruling Planet of Mars.

3: Quadrant Rulers

We have identified and established the rulers of each Quadrant on the Foundation layer, which is the same for all of us.

The 1st Quadrant is ruled by the Zodiac sign Aries and Key 4, The Emperor, which has the ruling Planet of Mars that is assigned to Key 16, The Tower.

The 2nd Quadrant is ruled by the Zodiac sign Cancer and Key 7, The Chariot, which has the ruling Planet of the Moon that is assigned to Key 2, The High Priestess.

The 3rd Quadrant is ruled by the Zodiac sign Libra and Key 11, Justice, which has the ruling Planet of Venus that is assigned to Key 3, The Empress.

The 4th Quadrant is ruled by the Zodiac sign Capricorn and Key 15, The Devil, which has the ruling Planet of Saturn that is assigned to Key 21, The World.

4: 3rd Quadrant: 7th House

As my life-line enters the 2nd half of my life, whereas my age will be approximately 52 years old, my Personality will presenting Capricorn expressions up until around the age of 55 years old, and then my life-line will enter Aquarius in the 7th House while also I experience the conjunction of my Sun and Mercury.

The 7th House and 3rd Quadrant is probably my most important area in my astrology chart that I should 'shine light' on because that is exactly what the 'intent' of my Sun is doing in my small 7th House.

The Sun symbolically provides a path on where my strongest 'intent', the Father archetype, the 'I Am', is radiating light and provides a gravitational pull for me to explore with life experiences the characteristics and expressions of 7th House qualities.

With my Mercury almost exactly the same degree of my Sun, which is less than 1 degree, I can know that I came into this life with not a lot of understanding in the 7th House area and I should consider serious thought that is provided by Mercury on my relationships and partnerships.

With Capricorn being the ruler of my 3rd Quadrant and 7th House along with Saturn being the ruling Planet for Capricorn, I can channel my Saturn in my 3rd House to assist my Capricorn expressions that will want to play out during this phase of my life, but also I can notice on the Foundation Layer that Libra rules the 7th House, which Saturn is exalted in Libra.

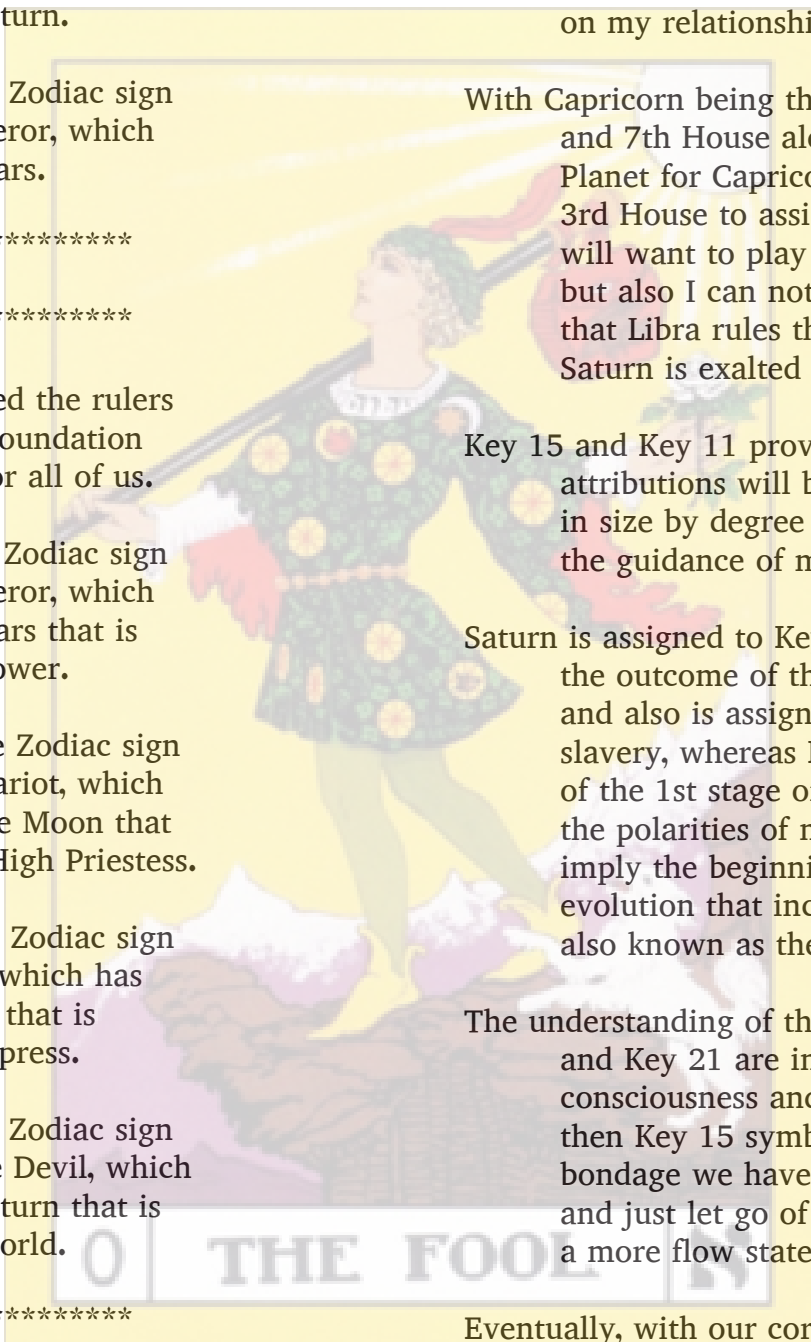
Key 15 and Key 11 provide clear indication that Saturn attributions will be vital for me to grow in size by degree my 7th House, but I also have the guidance of my Sun and Mercury.

Saturn is assigned to Key 21, The World, which is the outcome of the 7th stage of spiritual unfoldment and also is assigned the polarities of dominion and slavery, whereas Key 15, The Devil, is the outcome of the 1st stage of spiritual unfoldment and assigned the polarities of mirth and bondage, which this can imply the beginning and ending of our spiritual evolution that includes Saturn, also known as the Divine Mother.

The understanding of the polarities assigned to Key 15 and Key 21 are important because as we grow our consciousness and expand our awareness of ourselves, then Key 15 symbolizes that we can release the bondage we have on ourselves with laughter and just let go of old patterns of thought to obtain a more flow state for our spiritual evolution.

Eventually, with our correct interpretation of the necessity for limitations in any form of manifested existence is the secret of dominion, else the wrong interpretation will be the cause of our own slavery to conditions.

Furthermore, Key 9, The Hermit, also symbolizes endings and Divine Father, which indicated by the lantern as a beacon resembles a way-shower of light that my 3rd House of Virgo and 7th House of Capricorn, both Earth signs, can tune-in with each other as I explore my 3rd Quadrant of social development.

As I reflect on my life in this present Now moment while my life-line is currently in the 6th House, I can feel and know based off my choices over the past five to ten years that my current environment of life that I have constituted and shaped has referenced and focused on expanding my 7th House qualities with discernment.

My Sun is at 0 degrees of Aquarius which is considered a cusp for Capricorn, and although the Sun is in detriment within Aquarius, I can use the symbols and attributions of Tarot to assist with this difficult placement on my astrology chart.

Also, I feel that Key 9, The Hermit, who is alone at the top of the mountain is actually far from feeling alone and very much at peace, which this might appear as The Hermit has no established relationships, but symbolically it is that The Hermit has many relationships with all of Humanity because of the acquired capacity to have the oversight for the path already treaded, which all of us are on, but our paths just appear different, and some of us appear a little further along than others, yet we are all traveling together.

Within the seven stages of spiritual unfoldment, Key 15, The Devil, is the effect of appearance which can channel Key 9, The Hermit, that is the agency of response, and Key 21, The World, is the effect of signature, and on the Foundation layer Key 11, Justice, is the agency of action.

5: 3rd Quadrant: 8th House

As my life-line enters the 8th House around the age of 58 with now my Sun and Mercury activated, I can begin to focus on my experiences of changes that has occurred in my life which has provided assistance to my spiritual unfoldment and consciousness growth.

The 8th House on the Foundation layer is ruled by Scorpio with attributions of death, transformations, and occultism, which the word occult means 'secret' and this word can be specified in many ways, such as revealing within myself what I am ready to experience that maybe I am not currently aware of at this phase in my life.

Scorpio is ruled by Mars and Pluto, and both of these planetary archetypes have already been activated within me based on my life-line, so as I experience this phase in my life which is a small house of pre-birth 'need', I can express my Aquarius qualities on the Personality layer to assist with my consciousness growth and social development for the 3rd Quadrant.

Aquarius is ruled by Uranus and located in my 5th House of Scorpio on the Personality layer, which also means my Uranus is exalted and as I express myself during this life phase of age 58 to age 65, I can know that my pre-birth 'intent' of Uranus will provide strong expressions for my consciousness growth such as seen in Key 0, The Fool.

Key 17, The Star, is assigned to Aquarius and the female water-bearer symbolizes Truth without disguise as she maintains her balance and pours the water from two vases that represent self-consciousness and subconsciousness.

Meditation is the Aquarian function of a symbolic fish-hook that will seek ideas, that are symbolic fish, Key 13, Death, within the waters of our subconsciousness.

The red vases and red bird are the color of desire, just as the red roses within Key 1, The Magician, but there are only two white roses within Tarot which represent purified desires and they are in Key 0 and Key 13.

When I meditate and channel my 8th House ruled by Aquarius on the Personality layer, which is a small house and a pre-birth 'need', Key 17, The Star, reminds me that my naturalness of being is the thing desired, meaning, the white rose symbolizes the embodiment of a natural consciousness growth that will become an expression during this life phase because I will have lived long enough that my red roses of desires will have been experienced and fulfilled to the degree that a purified transformation will occur.

My 8th House is very clear with the symbols of Tarot, which Key 17, Key 0, and two Key 13 Scorpio signs provide powerful symbols of meditation on how I will grow my 3rd Quadrant of social development by symbolically going fishing with a fish-hook deep within my subconsciousness.

Within the seven stages of spiritual unfoldment, Key 17, The Star, is the effect of meditation, which can channel Key 13, Death, on both the Personality and Foundation layer, and is the agency of motion, but also Key 0, The Fool, which is all 22 Tarot Keys combined and represents Superconsciousness.

6: 3rd Quadrant: 9th House

As my life-line moves into the 9th House ruled by Pisces on the Personality layer around the age of 65 years old, I will activate my final two Planets of pre-birth 'intent' within my current life which are Venus and the Moon.

Both Planets in the 9th House are strong Divine Mother archetypes which Key 2, The High Priestess, symbolizes the subconsciousness and also the pre-cosmic, root-substance, prior to any manifestation and is beneath all objective planes of existence known as the First Mother and also the Virgin Mother.

In contrast to the cold, virgin, High Priestess of Key 2, is Key 3, The Empress, who is rather warm, pregnant, surrounded by life and growth, is the Great Mother of the world of form.

The Planet Venus is assigned to Key 3, The Empress, which is exalted in Pisces and symbolizes strong Venus expressions that I will exhibit and embody during this activation from age 65 to 73.

Let us remember that all ten Planetary archetypes do not just turn on and off, but are always available for our consciousness growth to channel at any degree within our life, at any life phase we experience, so we just need to have the awareness that we can channel these symbols that are powerful suggestions to our subconsciousness.

For example, in the previous lecture, we identified that Venus is the ruling Planet of Libra in my 4th House, which Libra is the ruler of my 2nd Quadrant and I can channel my Venus to assist with my family development by expressing 9th House characteristics and Key 3 attributions.

Within my 3rd Quadrant as my life-line creates a strong conjunction with my Venus and Moon archetypes, I will have the awareness to express a type of creative imagination that is provided by Divine Mother attributions.

We can also address the Divine Father attributions within the 9th House because Sagittarius is at home in the 9th House, which the Planet Neptune that is assigned to Sagittarius and located in my 6th House.

Sagittarius is assigned to Key 14, Temperance, which has many embedded symbols that represent Divine Father guidance such as the Rainbow of Promise and an Angel that is always supporting our consciousness growth and expansion.

Neptune is assigned to Key 12, The Hanged Man, and is also the higher octave of Venus, which ultimately means that we must learn to love ourselves in order to receive higher understandings from the Divine Mother which will create the ability to live with true compassion for all of Humanity and acquire, then embody, the Wisdom from Divine Father.

The Hanged Man appears to be in a very uncomfortable state of bondage, but he is actually in a state of absolute freedom because this symbol is to represent the mental attitude of reversal consciousness that is the exact reverse of popular opinion, or popular cultural influences.

My 3rd Quadrant explicitly provides the symbols of how I can grow my social development for consciousness growth in the 9th House which has the attributions of travel, higher education, philosophy, and spirituality, but the suggestion to channel Key 12, The Hanged Man, which is also considered a Mother Letter in Hebrew that represents the element water, everything will need to be turned upside down of what I thought was to be true so that my subconsciousness can reflect back Divine Truth.

We can also notice in Key 18, The Moon, has a golden path that progresses past the animal kingdom symbolized by the two dogs, then into a cultivated field which represents general knowledge until the golden path progresses between the two towers that symbolize the boundaries of general knowledge and into the Great Beyond of the Unknown for higher consciousness.

Within the seven stages of spiritual unfoldment, Key 18, The Moon, is the effect of organization, which can channel Key 14, Temperance, on both the Personality and Foundation layer, and is the agency of verification, and also Key 12, The Hanged Man, which is the agency of reversal.

7: 3rd Quadrant

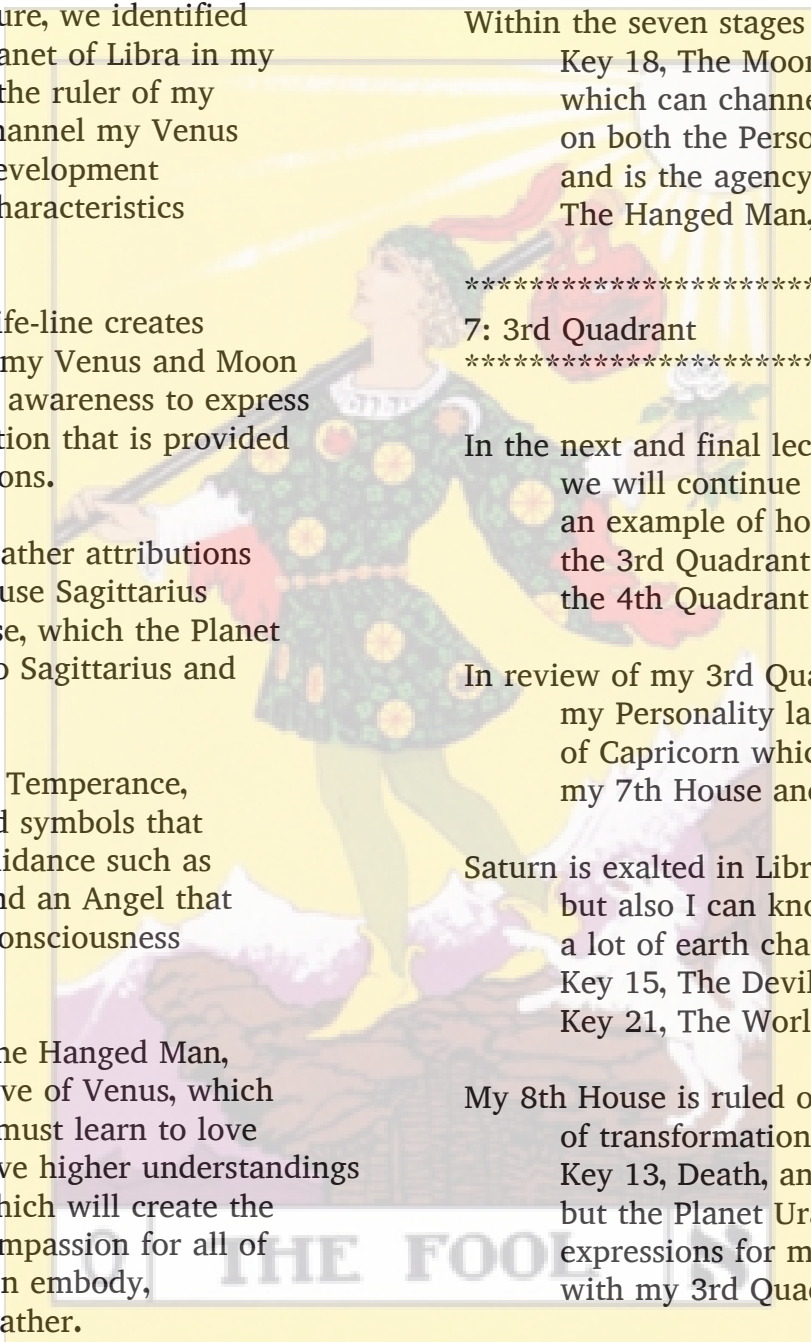
In the next and final lecture of this series, we will continue to use my astrology chart as an example of how our life-line moves from the 3rd Quadrant of social development into the 4th Quadrant of career development.

In review of my 3rd Quadrant of social development, my Personality layer has the Quadrant ruler of Capricorn which is the ascending cusp of my 7th House and also ruled by Saturn.

Saturn is exalted in Libra, which is on the Foundation layer, but also I can know that my 7th House is channeling a lot of earth characteristics as shown from Key 15, The Devil, Key 9, The Hermit, and Key 21, The World.

My 8th House is ruled of Aquarius has strong symbols of transformation represented by Key 17, The Star, Key 13, Death, and Key 0, The Fool, but the Planet Uranus will provide the expressions for my Personality to assist with my 3rd Quadrant social development.

My 9th House is ruled by Pisces and also has strong symbols of change that must occur in order to reach the awareness of the higher octave of Venus, which is Neptune qualities.

The Divine Mother archetype is strongly suggested in my 3rd Quadrant because Saturn is the ruler, but also my 9th House has Venus and the Moon which become activated with the attributions that will create strong Divine Mother expressions for my Personality, within the influence of strong Divine Father expressions from Sagittarius and Key 14, Temperance.

In summary of my 3rd Quadrant, the importance to understand that all four quadrants are developed in all moments of our life, and not only when our life-line moves from degree-to-degree, we need to know these ancient symbols for powerful suggestions to our subconsciousness that helps us purify our mind for obtaining higher consciousness and expanded awareness is really the true meaning of Astrology and Tarot.

How we choose to use these spiritual tools as gateways for remembrance of who we really are as multi-dimensional beings, is for our own freedom of choice, but let us know as seen in Key 14, Temperance, that the symbolic Angel and other Higher Intelligences are supporting our consciousness growth within Humanity.
